ELMWOOD SCHOOL Grant Funding 2017-18

Pupil Premium Grant (PPG)

The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) is additional government funding given to schools in order to enhance the progress, attainment and wellbeing of disadvantaged pupils. It is currently given to pupils in receipt of free school meals, children looked after by the Local Authority and the children of service personnel.

In 2017-18 Elmwood School was allocated £34,050 the following charts demonstrate what we anticipate the funding will be spent on and the impact it will have to disadvantaged children.

Elmwood school has 46% of pupils on roll eligible for Pupil Premium funding.

How the Governing Body holds school leaders to account for the spending of the Pupil Premium Grant.

The Executive Headteacher reports annually on how the Pupil Premium Grant has been spent in the previous year and the impact that it has had on pupil progress and well-being. It also reports on what it intends to spend the current year Pupil premium Grant on in order to enhance the progress and well-being in the next year.

Elmwood School Pupil Premium Provision Mapping 2017-18

The pupil premium is additional monies given to schools to support pupils who are considered disadvantaged. The chosen measure for this is the entitlement of Free School Meals within the past 6 years, service children and those who are in Care.

The current funding is approximately £34,050 in total. Estimated costs have been allocated in the following way.

Interventions: Personalised and targeted provision

Overview: Pupils who are at risk of disengaging to access targeted support through alternative provision.

Cost £ 5950

Aim/outcomes: Improved engagement in learning linked with accredited outcomes. Increase in confidence and aspiration and access to further education following school.

Interventions: To provide specialist SRE (Sex & Relationships education)

Overview: Specialist staff to work directly with the Local Authority advisor in this area to develop individualised and small group programmes.

Cost £ 5495

Aims/outcomes: To ensure all pupils have a good understanding of safe and appropriate sexual relationships. Confidence in using the sexual health traffic light tool to measure impact.

Interventions: Uniform Provision

Overview: School Uniform provided for those in most need

Cost: £ 400

Aim/Outcomes: To promote a sense of well-being and belonging to the school community through quality uniform provision

Interventions: Malachi Family support

Overview: To bridge the gap between home and school and ensure better outcomes for pupils.

Cost £4487

Aim/Outcomes: To ensure weekly contact throughout the year, to support families to engage with school and increase participation in school meetings.

Interventions: Family Team

Overview: To continue to provide support to families, including holiday support and a focus on attendance.

Cost £11,648

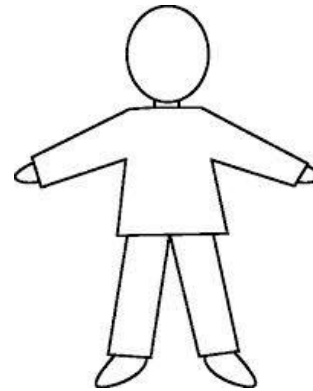
Aim/Outcomes: To improve family engagement and increase Early Interventions. To increase participation in PCR, TAC, CiN meetings.

Interventions: Nurture breakfast

Overview: To provide nurture breakfast for all pupils

Cost: £500

Aim/Outcomes: For all pupils to take part in nurture breakfast daily to support nurture principles and build positive relationships with peers and adults.



Supporting the whole child

Extra-Curricular after school Clubs Overview:

To provide a range of after-school clubs to encourage pupils to participate in active leisure and creative arts activities outside of the school day.

Cost £5570

Aims/outcomes: More pupils will participate in a range of extra-curricular activities and engage in after school clubs with positive impact to their self-esteem, self-confidence and making and maintaining friendships.
