Year 7 Catch up Literacy/ Numeracy Grant funding

Review 2018-19

The Year 7 catch up Literacy and the Year 7 catch up Numeracy Grant is provided to improve the attainment of students transferring to secondary school who fail to meet the identified target levels in Literacy and Numeracy in Year 6. It is used to provide the staffing and resources for the delivery of one-to-one and small group sessions to improve literacy and numeracy.

In 2018-19, a total of £6500 was available.

The funding was used to support English and Maths Interventions for pupils in Year 7.

Pupils received 1:1 tuition to boost the Maths and English teaching in the classroom.

A communication lead supported students with specific communication difficulties.

The funding was also used to purchase specific intervention resources for students who require additional support in reading and number.

Impact of the spend:

There were 13 Year 7 students during this year, 42% met or exceeded their target in reading, 75% in writing and spoken language.

In Maths, 75% of pupils met or exceeded their targets in number, 83% in Measure and 92% in Geometry.
